

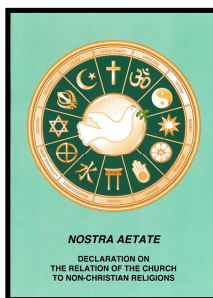

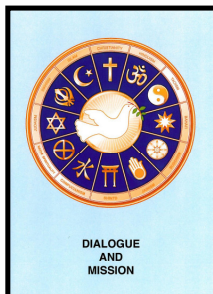

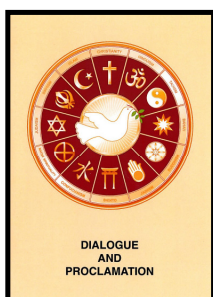
The Columban Mission Institute is delighted to print ***Nostra Aetate***, ***Dialogue and Mission***, and ***Dialogue and Proclamation*** and make them available in an inexpensive, attractive and handy-sized format for prayer, study and action. They are Catholic Church's key documents on interreligious dialogue and show the development in the Church's teaching as it has grown in the practice and theory of interreligious dialogue over the last half century.



Nostra Aetate, the Vatican II document on the Church's relation to Non-Christian religions, is widely regarded as a "watershed" in relations between Catholics and people of other religions. Popes John Paul II and Benedict XVI have both referred to it as the *Magna Carta* of dialogue for the Catholic Church. It lays the foundations of respect and esteem that should guide Catholics in their approach to believers from other religions.



The Attitude of the Church Towards the Followers of Other Religions: Reflection and Orientations on Dialogue and Mission addresses the questions about dialogue that arose in practice and in theory in the 20 years after the establishment of the Secretariat for Non-Christians, now known as the Pontifical Council for Interreligious Dialogue. It names the various tasks that make up the contemporary Church's mission; explains the foundations and forms of dialogue; and treats of the mutual relations between dialogue and mission.



Dialogue and Proclamation: Reflection and Orientations on Interreligious Dialogue and the Proclamation of the Gospel of Jesus Christ presents a developed Catholic teaching on interreligious dialogue. It is the fruit of five years of collaboration between the Pontifical Council for Interreligious Dialogue and the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples. It is the most sustained and profound reflection on interreligious dialogue in Catholic teaching. It presents the difficulties as well as the opportunities that dialogue and proclamation together offer in service of the Church and the growth of the Kingdom of God.


